A remains of a settlement built during the Stone Age. Proven to be older than Stonehenge and the Pyramids!

bronze: copper and tin are melted together to make a metal called

century: a period of 100 years gather: collect things together

settler: People who migrate to a new place

settlement: When people start a community, this is a settlement

trade: the activity of buying, selling, or exchanging goods or services

remains: traces of the past

nomads: People who go from place to place with no permanent home.

extinct: When a species of animal no longer exists it is extinct.


